Silent Auction

☞ Each bidder receives a bid number when they check in. This number serves as the bidder's silent and live bid number as well as the account number for checking out.

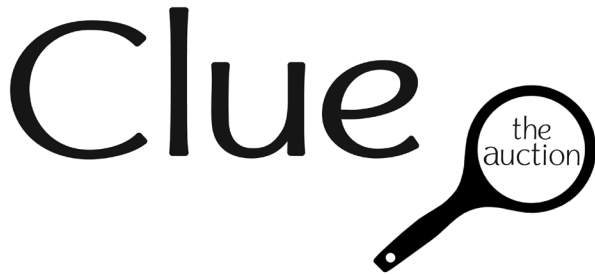
☞ The written or verbal bid constitutes a legal contract to purchase the item. **All purchases are final; there will be no exchanges or refunds on items unless otherwise noted.**
