## PNA Kids! Art Camp Overview

PNA Kids! is excited to offer a new art camp for kids in grades 2nd through 8th grade. With instructors dedicated to developing and nurturing the creativity in your child, students will explore a range of artistic expression from mixed media to cartooning. They will learn new concepts and techniques, allowing them to develop confidence in their abilities, but more importantly to have fun!

## Camp Sessions

### 1: June 22-26 — Mixed Media Creations

**Instructor Jeanne Dodds**

**AM 9am-12pm, 3rd-5th Grade**

**PM 1-4pm, 6th-8th Grade**

Explore a variety of 2D and 3D art media in this unique and hands-on mixed media class. Our project will be the creation of a house-shaped shadowbox, which we will fill with images and objects that express our personalities. Students will be inspired by artwork created by other assemblage artists, including work by other kids! Daily projects will include: assemblage construction, papermaking, printmaking, small-scale sculpture, mark making, painting, and more. Students are welcome to bring personal objects or photocopies of pictures to add to their unique and personal assemblage creation.

### 2: June 29-July 2 — Adventures in Printmaking

**PM 1-4pm, 6-8th Grade**

Discover the exciting creative world of printmaking in this fun and active class. We will

monoprint, block print, stencils, and more. Learn the magic of carving a linoleum block that can be used to create multiple images, print an original t-shirt design, and paint designs that will become one-of-a-kind prints. Projects will include self-portraits, abstraction, nature imagery, and other subjects. Students will create work to share with classmates and take home shirts, cards, and wall art at the end of the week.

### 3: July 6-10 — Biological Illustration: Illustrating Scenes and Creatures

Experience drawing outdoors. With sketch pad in hand, we will wander in the neighborhood to find scenes with creatures and plants to draw. Come dressed for the weather with something to sit on as we discover what wonder abounds in the neighborhood.

### 4: July 20-24 — Green Art

**Instructor Li-ting Hung & Susanne Lindberg-Jones**

**9am-12pm, 2nd-6th Grade**

Be the change you want in the world by making green art! We will transform a pile of recycled paper and turn them into a work of art. Students will learn the art of paper-making and use the hand-made paper to assemble a mixed-media book. Learn elements of art and principles of design by doing. You will walk away with good memories and a beautiful book of your own. Students please bring a bag of recycled paper to class. Also bring personal collections such as stamps, photos, leaves, or any special items you wish to assemble in your book.

### 5: July 20-24 — Colorful Art

**1-4pm, 4-6th Grade**

Are you drawn to colors? Have you ever had the urge to express your feelings with colorful art? In this class you will learn the art of color by experimenting with

watercolor, dry pastels and oil pastels. Students will draw and paint from photographs. Subject matters include birds, insects, plants, and sea creatures. Learn to use colors to convey the illusion of light, shade and shadow.

### 6: July 27-31 — Comics and Cartooning

**Instructor Greg Stump**

**1-4pm, 4-6th Grade**

Students enrolled in this class will explore the visual language of cartooning as they work towards creating a individual comic narrative from rough pencils to finished, inked artwork. Covered topics will include drawing characters, faces, figures, expressions, simple animation, basic perspective, and more. In-class exercises are designed to encourage creativity and occasional collaborations with classmates, and the lessons are designed to accommodate kids from all levels of ability and experience.

### 7: August 3-7 — Paper Maché: Create Your Own Mythical Creature

**1-4pm, 3rd-6th Grade**

We will create new animals and creatures from fables, myths, and your own imagination. Your final project will be your own invented creature. The class will come together, make sketches, examine books, ask questions, and create paper maché creatures. You'll walk away with a masterpiece of your own design.
