Summer Safari Overview

Calling all 5-12 year olds - come and experience a summer full of fun, hands-on education, experiences, and adventure!

Summer Safari offers children a bountiful array of daily choices. In addition to daily field trips, swimming, arts & crafts, science, drama, dance, cooking and outdoor recreation choices, children will be able to choose to participate in fun computer activities, take pictures, or join in the summer reading club.

Summer Safari offers two separate programs that meet the developmental needs of each age group. This provides children with a place where they can relax, play, and feel comfortable. Children learn social skills, conflict resolution, and positive self-esteem.

Kids Entering Grades K-2

Children entering grades K-2 participate in exciting activities designed to awaken a sense of wonder and encourage exploration of their surroundings. Children are encouraged to explore, discover, learn, and have fun!

Kids Entering Grades 3-6

Separate programming for children entering grades 3-6 offers older school-age children the opportunity to develop friendships, a chance to participate in challenging and fun activities, and learn new skills.

1: June 22 - 26 — Monster Mash

2: June 29 - July 2 (CLOSED July 3) — Kids in the Kitchen

It's a tour for the taste buds! Dare to taste what you've never tasted before as we take a trip around the world through cooking. Get a glimpse of what goes on behind the scenes at some of your favorite local eateries and make pizza at Zeek's. Wow your friends and family with your new knowledge of cooking and your own handmade recipe book.

3: July 6 - 10 — Maritime Madness

It's a week of nautical nonsense as we cruise through Seattle's many bodies of water. Ride a ferry, float around Greenlake, and learn what keeps a boat afloat. The week will end with a bang as we compete in the Seafair Milk Carton Derby!
