Option to make pledges during Fund-A-Need

Guests will raise their bid card as normal during this section of the program. At the end of the evening, if a guest chooses the pledge option, they will fill out the pledge card form on their table and put it in the large envelope on the table. Pledges must be returned to these envelopes so we can process them. An event volunteer will collect the envelopes at the end of the evening.

Staff will follow up with guests who make pledges by April 30. Pledges can be spread out for up to 8 months. Example: Instead of paying \$1000 at the end of the night, a guest could pay \$125/mo May through December.
