V.I.K. Parade entries will start at 95th and Greenwood and will disperse on 3rd Ave NW just after the Fred Meyer parking lot.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

For insurance liability reasons and for the safety and enjoyment of the parade by the spectators, we ask that you **do not** throw objects from your unit. Parade participants may give out candy; however, you should walk along the curb and hand it to the spectators. We discourage handing out flyers as most of them end up on the ground. **Please do not bring bubbles as it makes the street slippery for units that follow.**

Any motorized unit in the parade will be inspected for leaks at the start line. If the vehicle leaks any fluids it will not be permitted on the route.

*Please follow the direction of the Seattle Police Department in dropping off participants.
Please also follow the directions of the Seafair Parade Marshals.*

Please be respectful of our neighborhood and it's residents.

Trophies will be presented during the Award Ceremony at the Grandstand on N. 85th in the **Fred Meyer** parking lot **IMMEDIATELY** following the parade. Please bring your group or send a representative to the Grandstand **AFTER** the parade. If you have been awarded a trophy, it must be picked up at the ceremony.
