Volunteer Position Description Adopt-a-Grand

Purpose: Adopt-a-Grand is a volunteer program designed to provide an opportunity for elders and families with children to create meaningful one-on-one connections. This program will help children better understand the aging process while developing a sense of social responsibility and community awareness.

Location and times: Visits will be at a mutually agreed upon location, often the elder's home. Visits will occur once per month, lasting between 30 minutes and a few hours, depending on the agreed-upon activity and age of participating child(ren). Both sets of Grands will commit to at least one year.

Key Responsibilities:

- Coordinate meeting times with adopted Grand.
- Agree upon activities and/or chores.
- Perform activities together.
- Report volunteer time.

Reports to: PNA Village Coordinator

Time Commitment: 30 minutes to a few hours per month, for at least one year.

Qualifications:

- Families must be interested in spending time with a local senior.
- At least one adult (18+) must submit PNA volunteer application, pass background check and attend Village Volunteer training.
- Participating elders must be a current PNA Village Member.
